GESTURE TOPICS

Objective

To provide participants with the opportunity to practise and develop natural gestures.

Procedure

Those answering the topics are asked to do so using gestures and the evaluators are asked to emphasise this aspect in their evaluations. The topics chosen should be ones that lend themselves to the use of gestures. Some examples follow.

- 1. Show us how to iron a shirt.
- 2. Demonstrate the changing of a fuse wire.
- 3. Let us see how you would sew on a button.
- 4. Show us how you would hang wallpaper.
- 5. How would you make a cup of tea.
- 6. Give directions to your house.
- 7. Explain a spiral staircase.
- 8. Give us a lesson on changing a car tyre.
- 9. Demonstrate your knitting skill.
- 10. Show us how you would hang a picture straight.
- 11. Show us how to select and peel potatoes.
- 12. Demonstrate how to change a nappy.
