## NOUGHTS \& CROSSES - CLUB OPERATION QUIZ

## Objective

To review and reinforce knowledge of a subject, typically at the end of a training session. This example of the game is based on the T.I. Club Constitution and The Standard Bylaws.

## Procedure

Number a conventional noughts and crosses grid on a board/flip chart. Two teams are then asked questions alternately.
