

What's your 'Life Philosophy'?

Oh, I have plenty of those! Here are a few that spring to mind are... Give more than you take; It's not what life deals you, it's how you deal with life; and... Always be grateful for what you have.

We all know you were born in Parramatta, but what are a few things that our members might not know about you?

- In 1986, I ran the City to Surf in 00:59:21!
- I've worked as a volunteer at the Matthew Talbot Hostel for homeless men for the past 22 years.
- I'm "a qualified greenie" i.e I have a degree in Environmental Biology.

What would you say to a prospective member thinking about joining a Toastmasters Club?

Just do it! You can't learn to swim by sitting on the side of the pool. And you can't become a proficient swimmer without expert coaching. The same applies to public speaking. There are no substitutes for stage time and practice, but the value really comes from giving and receiving evaluations. That's what Toastmasters do best.
